Dear Friends of Camp Challenge,

Enclosed you will find a copy of the Camp Challenge year end letter that has been prepared by our Executive Director, Brian Klein. The letter provides an update on recent progress that has been made at Camp Challenge and asks for your financial support.

What Brian's letter does not mention is that there is a significant need at Camp Challenge that affects him personally. The camp house, in which Brian and Maria and their children reside, has a significant moisture and mold issue. The mold issue is so severe that the Kleins had to move out of the house for the safety and health of their family. They are currently living in the efficiency apartment above the camp's Administration Building.

Brian has been very hesitant to even mention this issue. However, I recently toured the camp house and it is worse than I had anticipated. Due to drainage issues, water continually enters the crawl space and the roof is leaking. All of this must be fixed before the mold remediation can begin. This is a significant expense and we are still evaluating if it would more economical to tear the house down and build another one.

Due to the seriousness of the problem with the camp house, I would ask you to consider doubling the amount of what you might normally give to Camp Challenge. We have been blessed with a donor that agreed to make a significant matching donation of individual donations made between now and the end of the year:

Donations up to \$1,000 will receive a 50% match
Donations of \$1,000 - \$1,999 will receive a 100% match
Donations of \$2,000 - \$4,999 will receive a 150% match
Donations of \$5,000 - \$10,000 will receive a 200% match
