



SESSION HEALTH STAFF

Camp Challenge is a Christian camp and retreat center in south central Indiana. We exist to develop followers of and leaders for Jesus Christ by encouraging disconnection with everyday distractions and reconnection to God through His creation. We are in search of session health staff for one or more of our summer camp sessions. Health staff are expected to attend the staff and volunteer retreat and be in residence for the duration of the camp session. Health staff will work closely with camp staff and each camp's session director.

Responsibilities

- Review camper medical history and medications during check-in
- Staff nurse's station (be on call to administer medications and treat minor injuries and conditions 24 hours a day throughout the duration of the camp session)
- Keep camp medical log up-to-date and fill out required reports as needed
- Advise camp staff when outside medical attention is necessary

Qualifications

- Certified in the American Red Cross' Standard First Aid Course or its equivalent
- Additionally trained, licensed, or certified in the medical field (EMT, RN, LPN, MD, etc. experienced preferred)
- Mature in their Christian walk with Jesus Christ
- Highly responsible
- Comfortable with campers of varying backgrounds
- Recommended of their current pastor
- Able to pass a criminal history background check

Time Commitment

- Staff and volunteer training retreat (Fri evening-Sat afternoon the 3rd weekend in May)
- 2 hours prior to camp check-in opening day until 1 hour after pick-up closing day

Compensation

- Stipend of \$225 per session is offered (1/2 for Young Explorers)
- All meals during your session
- Private lodging during your session
